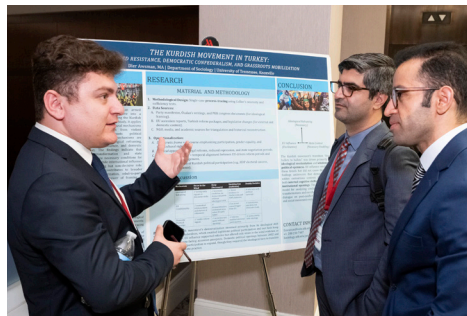
Nineteenth Annual Conference.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS:

- Undergraduate applicants must be juniors or seniors in the 2026–27 academic year.
- Graduate applicants must be enrolled at a higher education institution for the 2026–27 academic year.
- Interested students must submit an application via the online submission portal and include a 300-word abstract of original unpublished data, a brief letter of reference from an advisor or department chair and a C.V. or resume.
- Topics must be related to the Middle East and/or Africa.
- Successful applicants will be required to register for the Conference.
- Limited travel scholarships available for confirmed participants.
- **Applications are evaluated and accepted on a rolling basis until October 5, 2026.**
